POLICY STATEMENT

As Managing Director of Omega Red Group Ltd, I recognise and accept my responsibility to ensure, so far as reasonably practicable, safe and healthy working conditions for all Company employees and others who may be affected by our activities. The health and safety performance of the branches, departments and individuals will be monitored for compliance with the policy, and with a commitment to continually striving for improvement. The Company is committed to providing adequate resources for planning, implementation, monitoring and review of the Health and Safety Policy.

Senior Management will review this Policy at least annually to ensure its continuing suitability and effectiveness. They will also ensure that adequate resources are made available to meet the Policy commitments.
